We are inviting you to contribute a full-length paper to a Collection (former Special Issue) on "Harmonisation within Atmospheric Dispersion Modelling" for publication in the journal

In a **Collection**, articles which belong together in the form of a special issue are now released in a dedicated collection page on the journal homepage. Therefore, articles are directly added to the collection upon publication, and that collection remains on the journal homepage in perpetuity. Harmo23 Collection will be closed, such as conceived for a former Special Issue.

AIRQ - like many journals - is moving from the old model of publishing articles online first and then later allocating those to an issue, to the new model called Continuous Article Publication (CAP) in which articles are directly allocated to an issue upon publication.

It is important to know that for an AIRQ Collection only full papers that had not been published elsewhere, including websites of conferences, can be accepted.

Therefore:

- ✓ Submitted papers should not have been previously published nor be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- ✓ Conference papers (including your extended abstract submitted to HARMO23) may only be submitted if the paper has been completely rewritten. *Please be careful to avoid duplication of material from your HARMO23 extended abstract published online on www.harmo.org website*
- ✓ AIRQ Papers are on average between 10-12 pages to adhere to the average page count of a regular article.
- ✓ All papers are refereed through a peer-review process and acceptance for the HARMO23 conference is not a guarantee for publication in AIRQ journal.
- ✓ All papers must be submitted online through the Editorial Manager system which the journal uses for all submissions, <https://www.editorialmanager.com/airq/default1.aspx>
- ✓ IMPORTANT: when submitting the manuscript in the drop-down menu the following title should be selected for our Collection: HARMO23.
- ✓ When preparing your papers, please closely follow the submission guidelines of the journal: <https://www.springer.com/journal/11869/submission-guidelines>
- ✓ Deadline: Your manuscript is due by: **14/09/2026.**
